In 1994, Tim and Mark searched through Tim's archives of field tapes. Mark remastered a series of tracks to create the first Music Maker CD called *A Living Past* (shown) which came with a special brochure, now a collector's item.

Music Maker started from zero. Today, Music Maker is endorsed by music icons like BB King, Eric Clapton, Bonnie Raitt, and many others.
